## OUR KEYNOTE SPEAKER – AARON TUCKER

Aaron Tucker is an Executive Consultant for Afterburner, Inc. He is a decorated Navy SEAL with sixteen years in the Naval Special Warfare community. He specializes as human intelligence, communications and is a high-risk instructor with multiple combat deployments in support of Operation Enduring, and Iraqi Freedom. He has mentored and trained numerous foreign forces, as well as Navy, Army, and others in special operations tasks and roles. Aaron is also part of the fire service family; his father is a retired Virginia Beach firefighter.

### HANDS-ON TRAINING

#### **FLASHOVER SIMULATOR/FF SURVIVAL**

Recognize the critical warning signs of flashover and the science related to fire development.

#### **RESIDENTIAL – LIVE BURN (CLASS A)**

Develop skills including hose handling, search, and communications.

#### **TAXPAYER – LIVE BURN**

Develop skills for the commercial structure fireground skills including: hose handling, search, and communications.

#### **RIT-FIREFIGHTER RESCUE**

Learn to operate on Rapid Intervention Crew (RIC) with skills including: air management, emergency communications, downed firefighter removal, and self-survival.

#### **STANDPIPE OPERATIONS**

This course will outline tasks that will always be performed before firefighters advance a hoselines.

#### **PUMP OPERATIONS**

Refresh your skills hydraulics and perform basic pump operations, foam, and relay pumping.

#### **STREET SMART LADDERS**

Firefighters will perform VEIS, rescues, removals and learn the leg lock, arm lock, and new advanced methods to raise and extend portable ladders.

#### **ADVANCED MASK CONFIDENCE**

Learn wall breaching, moving through confined spaces, communications, self-removal from entanglements, mayday, and situational awareness.

#### **LINE OFFICER BOOT CAMP**

Line officers will learn about communications, line placement, safety, officer's position, and problem-solving on the fireground.

### **CHIEF OFFICER WORKSHOP**

Chiefs will discuss fireground operations in this interactive training.

### **ADVANCED VEHICLE EXTRICATION**

This class challenges firefighters with difficult extrication scenarios. Students will extricate victims from vehicles staged in precarious positions.

### **MAN VS. MACHINE**

Whether it's a basic ring removal or a full entrapment involving agricultural equipment you will learn the steps necessary to perform these extrications.

### **FIRE POLICE (MORNING SESSION ONLY)**

This class teaches the tactics necessary to ensure that all personnel operates safely on dangerous roadways.

Experience firefighting through a young firefighter's eyes up through the ranks serving as a chief. Learn what is expected of each unit operating through the eyes of the chief on the scene. Active participation is encouraged and expected!

A deadly gas explosion in Manhattan's East Village led to one of FDNY's most complex operations. Students will discuss: size up, initial operations, apparatus positioning, collapse, maydays and urgents, and emergency roll call procedures.
